A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE CITY OWNED 4.7 ACRES AT THE ENTRYWAY TO THE CITY OF THE HIGHLANDS BE DESIGNATED AS A CITY PARK AND DEVELOPED BY USING THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE STATE ALCOHOL TAX, DESIGNATED FOR SUCH USE.

WHEREAS the City of The Highlands receives state alcohol distributions designated for Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS the City of The Highlands does not have any land designated for Parks and Recreation usage; and

WHEREAS the state alcohol distributions may only be used for the development and maintenance of Parks and Recreation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE HIGHLANDS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the city owned 4.7 acres at the entryway be designated as a city park.

Section 2. That the state alcohol distributions be used to develop and maintain the newly designated park area for the benefit and enjoyment for the citizens of The City of The Highlands.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval by the City Council.
