- 2. The water district personnel will need to be contacted to get permission to extend clean-up of the area just west of The Highland's sign. The council would like to extend the clean-up west of the sign to complement the landscaping being planned for the entrance.
- 3. North of the entrance there is an enormous amount of dead wood, trash, brush, and trees to be removed along with possible dirt work to level out to allow proper drainage.
- 4. A question was raised (by a guest present) about any planned city-wide trash clean-up that might need to take place prior to the June 6 Bicycle Ride.
