**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR PARKING AND LITTERING VIOLATIONS**

**Whereas**, it is within the responsibility of the City's governing body to maintain a safe environment for citizens;

**Whereas**, Ordinance NO 2020-21, Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities was adopted January 28, 2021;

**Whereas**, in an effort to promote consistency in the application of the fine schedule; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of The Highlands as follows;**


SECTION 1. **Agreement.** The Council acknowledges Ordinance NO 2020-21, Section 1.5 Penalty for Scheduled Fines and the suggestions from State Statute 8-2118 in determining the costs assessed for each parking violation or littering violation within the incorporated areas of the City of The Highlands.

SECTION 2. **Implementation.** The council directs that the following schedule of fines is adopted:

- a. Parking in the Right of Way between dusk to dawn: (K.S.A. 8-1569)
  - Warning for first violation, must be resolved within 5 (five) days
  - \$50.00 for second violation plus court costs (\$140.00)
  - Double for third violation plus court costs (\$140.00)
- b. Parking within these restricted areas at any time: (K.S.A. 8-1571)
  - 15 feet of a fire hydrant
  - 20 feet of the driveway entrance to fire station
  - 30 feet of a stop sign
  - \$50.00 for first violation plus court costs (\$140.00)
  - Double for second violation plus court costs (\$140.00)
- c. Littering and/or dumping (K.S.A. 8-15,102) Litter means rubbish, refuse, waste material, garbage, trash or debris of whatever kind or description and includes improperly discarded paper, metal, plastic or glass.
  - \$115.00 plus court costs (\$140.00).

SECTION 3. Effective Date. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect after approval by the City Council.


