**IV. Recommendations/Plan**

A. Hire an engineer to confirm elevations, GPS markers, and any other items that will assist in the continuing development of drainage and road improvements.

- Jeff Jackson will contact the engineer from Kansas Association of Counties as suggested by Kristen Zimmerman, PEC, at the first February council meeting.

B. Monroe Street – Grant Township is working on improving the drainage situation. Working with an engineer will help in making sure that the proper steps are being taken at the appropriate time during this project.

C. Will pursue purchasing Lot 120 from the Hovious Trust which would allow for establishment of a rock road to tie into Hendricks and 108<sup>th</sup> for a safety exit on the north and west side of The Highlands. Once the engineer's report has been completed, can begin work on building an exit road, possibly from Wildwood to Hendricks. Reno County has stated they would maintain 108<sup>th</sup> and Grant Township will maintain Hendricks in this vicinity.

- Jeff Jackson will follow-up with the owner of this lot to determine purchase price.

D. Overall drainage projects in the City – driveways without culverts can impact the drainage in certain areas.
