**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE HIGHLANDS, KANSAS
APPOINTING A REPLACEMENT TO SERVE AS COUNCIL MEMBER.**

WHEREAS, on February 02, 2020, Mark Kerschen, an elected Council Member, submitted his resignation from the position as Council member to the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, on February 06, 2020 the council officially accepted Mark Kerschen's resignation resulting in a vacancy on the City Council by a majority vote; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City Charter No 2, a vacancy on the City Council shall be impartially and without favoritism, be nominated by the City Mayor; and

WHEREAS, upon a majority vote by the city council for approval, the appointee shall hold that office until the next regular election;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE City Council of the City of The Highlands:

Section 1. That the above findings are hereby true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2. That the nomination of Jannalee Boggs, by the Mayor and the majority approval vote of the remaining council members, has passed, and that Jannalee Boggs shall hold such office in accordance with City Charter Ordinance No. 2, Section 3, and shall qualify by oath of office or affirmation before the City Mayor prior to taking office.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effective upon approval by the City Council of the City of The Highlands, Kansas.
